# From the Principal's Desk

Dear Johnson Families:

Thank you again for your patience as our school district navigates our desire to get children back into learning and navigating what that should look like during a pandemic. In my last communication, I outlined the goals and guidelines we will follow when we are in face-to-face learning phases. As Johnson positions to meet the challenge of educating all children in a changing environment, we are focused on developing a system that allows



us to pivot at a moment's notice from one phase of learning to the next.

Our remote education offering will look different than it did last spring. We hope to keep the things that worked well, and we are committed to making our remote offering easy for students and families to access. To this end, each teacher has a learning page. The learning pages are accessed the same way for each student. We are also launching a new website next week that is easier to use on mobile devices.

You can expect a published, structured schedule of learning for each grade level. An overview of a week's lessons with both synchronous (real time) lessons and asynchronous (time to be determined by you) learning. We will be combining technology and traditional modes of learning.

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# **School Supply Lists**

#### **Teacher Assignments**

This has been a very intensive process with balancing class placement requests from April, A/B requests, students who have decided to attend PSDV this year, considering academic and behavioral needs of students, and now going back to remote learning.

# **ParentVUE**

Parents/guardians can access grades, attendance, and other student information through Synergy parent portals. Complete secure logon through the <u>ParentVUE</u> or through the apps, which can be downloaded from the <u>iTunes</u> <u>Store</u> and <u>Google Play</u>.

Parents/guardians can only see their student's information. Parents/guardians must have "educational rights" to access ParentVUE. Once educational rights are reflected in Synergy, parents will receive an email with a user activation code.

Classroom teachers will be putting together BTSN videos that will include information about academics and what the school year will look like in terms of academics and grade level standards. # **Parent Communication from Johnson**

Poudre School District policy does not allow the distribution of non-District communications to students through our school.
