Device Repair and Spare Laptop Swap Services

PSD recently unveiled a new laptop repair/swap program for student laptops. We thank everyone for their patience, as families and students navigate this new environment using laptops.



Troubleshooting of laptops will continue to be handled remotely through teachers or PSD technical staff by emailing covidtechhelp@psdschools.org. Only laptops for which troubleshooting took place remotely with teachers and/or technical staff and have been found to be unusable are eligible for a repair or exchange for a spare laptop.

The PSD staff member who worked with a family member/student to provide technical support and determined the laptop is unusable will share details about the location to which they should take the broken laptop and receive a replacement device. The replacement will be provided in support of remote learning for the remainder of the school year.

Early Childhood Education will accept online applications

Due to COVID-19 building closure at all schools, the PSD Early Childhood Education (ECE) program is modifying the way families can apply for our programs to receive services. Before the closure, the ECE application process was largely paper-based, and home visits and preschool learning took place in-person.

Beginning with the 2020-2021 program year, applications and all the necessary enrollment forms will be posted on [our web page](#). Once complete, electronic applications and documentation should be emailed to PSDECE@psdschools.org. The ECE team will notify families by email, rather than USPS mail, about their eligibility and/or enrollment status. Intake interviews will take place over the phone, rather than in-person.

A secure online registration platform will be available at alphabest.org/poudreco.

AlphaBEST's before-school programs will run 6:30 a.m. until the site school's first bell Mondays through Fridays; after-school programs will operate from the time of a site school's dismissal until 6 p.m.

[AlphaBEST's rates](#) are about 20-25 percent lower, as compared with rates of PSD's former before- and after-school care provider. Families who qualify for free or reduced-price meals, active military members and PSD employees are eligible for discounts. - There are two Johnson schools listed. The address is with it, so finding our is easy and at the top. (4101 Seneca Street) Click “**enroll**”

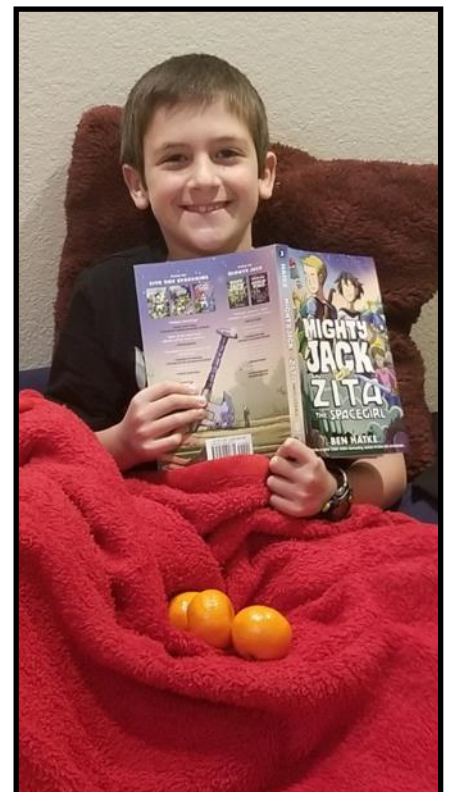
