# **PSD Virtual**

The district has set August 21<sup>st</sup> from 8:00 am to 11:00 am for device pick-up for our students who have enrolled in PSD Virtual. We will have staff stationed out front with a device checked out to your child through our media system. Please watch our newsletter for updates as we get closer to this date.

If you have enrolled your child with PSD Virtual this school year, but are still considering returning to Johnson Elementary, you may make that change up until the first day of school. Please call our school office if you have questions (970-488-5000).

# PSD Virtual:

PSD Virtual was established as a yearlong 100 percent online education option for the 2020-21 school year as an alternative for PreK-12 families who opted for the consistency of learning online all the time. PSD Virtual will not shift among the <u>district's educational phases</u>, which are dependent on current public health conditions, guidance and orders. <u>Watch this video</u> to learn more about what is different between PSD Virtual and remote education in a student's home school.

Enrolled PSDV students will pick up their laptops at their home schools. The deadline to register for PSDV was August 8.

#### **Teacher Assignments**



**Class Lists will not be posted on the school doors this year.** Instead, families will be able to see who your child's teacher is via <u>ParentVUE</u>. Our hope is that finalized class lists will be available on August 17. This has been a very intensive process with balancing class placement requests from April, A/B requests, removing students who have decided to attend PSDV this year, and considering academic and behavioral needs of students. Thank you for your patience as we create class lists.

#### Back-to-School Night

Our Back-to-School Night will be offered in a virtual format this year. Classroom teachers will be putting together BTSN videos that will include information about academics and what the school year will look like in terms of academics and grade level standards. Our teachers will be available for a virtual question and answer. We had planned on August 24<sup>th</sup>, but may need to change this to accommodate our materials



distribution and meet your teacher days. Watch for future details on our back to school night in our newsletter and from your child's teacher.

#### **School Meals**

District staff are actively planning for the critical distribution of meals during this period of remote education. We will share more information soon.

# PSD assessing laptop, internet needs: Log into PVUE now

Aug. 10, 2020

Dear PSD families,

PSD is continuing to survey families to determine which students need a laptop device and reliable internet services to access remote learning this fall.

- Parents and guardians should log into <u>ParentVUE</u> and go to the "Student Information" (Student Info) screen.
- Please review or indicate laptop needs for EACH of your students, as well as review or modify your response to having reliable internet services in your home.
- To make changes, click on the "Edit Information" button. If modifications are made, click "Save Changes" at the top of the screen. The deadline to complete these important steps is midnight Thursday, Aug. 13.

If a family indicates they don't need a district-issued device, PSD may distribute it to a student who doesn't have one. PSD has purchased MiFi devices (portable internet hotspots that enable students to engage in remote education wherever they are) and will distribute those to families who have shared that they have insufficient internet connectivity in their home to complete their work.

PSD has a long-standing one-to-one technology program in place that provides laptop devices to students in grades 3-12. This summer, PSD ordered devices for all kindergarten through second-grade students, as well. Due to global supply chain delays, however, it is likely that PSD will not receive these devices until sometime later this fall. While the district awaits delivery of these K-2 laptop devices, families can help PSD fill the gap to ensure all students have devices for remote learning.

#### When will laptops be distributed?

Since Friday's announcement, we've heard from numerous families with questions about when their student will receive their PSD-issued device. Schools will communicate when and how distribution will occur.

The district will provide how-to guides for families to learn how to navigate these primary learning management applications that will be used this year to support their students (Google Classroom, Microsoft Teams, etc.). More information about the how-to guides and other IT support will be available soon on the <u>Technical Support and Resources web page</u>.

# Having issues with ParentVUE?

If you are experiencing issues logging into ParentVUE, please refer to <u>ParentVUE support and</u> <u>FAQs</u> found on the District website. If you have previously logged into ParentVUE, select the option to reset your password. If you do not see an email from the system, we recommend you check your junk mail or spam folder. If you still cannot access it following these steps, please email <u>covidtechhelp@psdschools.org</u>.

# Parent Communication from Johnson

One of our goals at Johnson Elementary is to be eco-friendly. We send parent communication: newsletters, flyers, and weekly updates, through School Messenger. We post copies of newsletters and updates to the Johnson website on a weekly basis. The **Thunderbird Update** is published and sent via School Messenger each Thursday, except the first week of each month when the **Thunderbird Times** is published.



The email address you provide during registration is used to send communications from PSD and Johnson Elementary.

Poudre School District policy does not allow the distribution of non-District communications to students through our school. PSD offers other options for any vendor, group, organization, or business wishing to distribute advertising through school newsletters and activity flyer packets. Organizations can purchase advertising in individual school newsletters through the <u>School</u> <u>Communications Agency</u>. 60% of revenue from advertising goes back to the school to be used at the principal's discretion. Contact: (970) 239-1641.
