Federal government approves Colorado waiver to reduce CMAS tests in spring 2021

On March 26, the Colorado Department of Education announced that the state legislature and U.S. Department of Education reduced the Colorado Measures of Academic Success (CMAS) tests that students will take in spring 2021 due to the unique circumstances Colorado schools and districts are facing as a result of the pandemic. Parents have the options to opt their students out of the testing outlined below (deadline by April 9). If a family would like to have their child take an optional test, we will also need to know that by April 9. They may do so by completing the necessary forms digitally by logging into <u>ParentVUE</u> and accessing Services Tracker. Instructions <u>are available here</u>.
