Student Code of Conduct

Each year, parents/guardians and secondary students must acknowledge that they have reviewed the Student Rights and Code of Conduct, which is a compilation of rules, policies and regulations regarding student behavior.

Parents/guardians will be asked to acknowledge they have reviewed the Student Rights and Code of Conduct when they log into the <u>ParentVUE parent portal</u>. Parents/guardians will not be given access to ParentVUE until they electronically sign the acknowledgment. This box only needs to be checked once per year (once for elementary students and once for secondary students, if you have students in the different grade levels) to gain access to ParentVUE.

Parents of students in secondary schools (6-12): Your student will also be asked to acknowledge having received and reviewed the Students Rights and Code of Conduct when logging into StudentVUE for the first time this school year.

Transportation Update

We want to thank parents for your patience with bus schedules during these first days of school. We also want to share a helpful tool with you!

The "Here Comes the Bus" app helps parents know where their child's bus is. <u>Here Comes the Bus</u>, which provides the real-time location of each bus, can be accessed through desktop or mobile devices. The information is secure, provided to parents through a private ID that grants access to only their child's bus information. **Full-access subscriptions are free to PSD parents.**

The app is available in the <u>Apple iTunes Store</u> or <u>Google Play.</u> To create an account, use the **PSD school code 75840**.

The app is designed to increase convenience for parents during hectic mornings and provide another layer of safety for students. Schedule changes and bus delays due to traffic or weather are easy to find, and users can choose to receive push notifications when the bus is within five minutes of their stop.

Fall 2021 Health/Safety Protocols

Visit the <u>PSD Health and Safety website</u> for the most up to date information regarding district COVID protocols for schools. The district continues to follow guidance and orders from public health officials to meet evolving health and safety requirements and to implement district COVID protocols.

Fall 2021 School Return

- **Symptom Screening**: Please screen your child for symptoms prior to sending him/her to school. Can I go to school symptom check
- **Handwashing:** We will wash hands in the classroom
 - each morning upon entering,
 - before lunch,
 - after every recess
 - o after every cough or sneeze, and
 - o after using the restroom
 - Students may bring a personal lotion to use.
- **Surface areas**: Will be sanitized routinely throughout the day and in the evening.
- **Arrival:** Students may arrive on the Johnson campus at 8:35 AM. Students can play on our playgrounds or go to breakfast at this time. When the school bell rings, K-1 students should line up on our playground for teachers to bring them into the building, and 2-5th grade students line up at their classroom doors. Students will not use the main entrance if at all possible.
- **Playground:** Students will have recess while at school. The Johnson playground will be closed to other students and visitors Monday Friday from 8:30a 3:30p.
- **Dismissal:** All students are dismissed through exterior doors
- **Breakfast/Lunch**: Sack breakfast is available in our cafeteria at 8:35 AM. Breakfast service ends at 8:50 AM. If you send your child after this time, make sure they have had breakfast. Two sack lunch choices will be available. Lunches brought from home should include items that children can open independently. We are planning on meals being eaten in our cafeteria or outside (as the weather allows).
- **Masks**: Cloth or disposable masks must be worn at all times except when eating. Please send a spare mask in your child's backpack. As stated previously, please make sure your child has a clean mask every day. Masks are not required when outdoors. Students can put their masks on as they enter into the building.
- **Snack/water bottles**: Students may bring a small snack and one or two full water bottles. Bottle fillers will be used this year for refilling. No other personal items (toys, recess equipment) should be brought from home.
- **Cohorts:** Students will interact with students in their **classroom cohort**. This will be about 16-25 students. A few students may interact with a small group of students from other classrooms to receive specialized instruction for GT, special education, or

- intervention. In all cases, students will be spaced 3 feet or more apart during those specialized services where possible.
- **Spacing:** Students will be spaced 3 ft apart when possible. Some classrooms are configuring with a learning partner for social emotional reasons and because of space restrictions.
- **Attendance:** Attendance will be taken daily. If your child is ill, please call our attendance line at 970-488-5095. Please describe the symptoms related to the illness in case we need to begin contact tracing and other protocols.
- **Recess:** Students will go out to recess 2-3 times a day to the playgrounds. While outside, students are not expected to wear masks. They can play with whomever they wish to within their grade level.
- **Contact tracing:** We will use targeted trace contact methods if we have a COVID positive case.
- When students are absent: We will follow our normal policies of providing missed work for students to complete. Teachers may check in with students who are absent, but students will not access the classroom remotely. See note about learning pages.
- **Learning pages:** Learning pages will continue to be updated.

Daily Schedule

School hours for students in Kinder – 5th Grade are 8:50 a.m. to 3:28 p.m. **Students should not arrive at school before 8:35 a.m. unless attending AlphaBEST childcare, or a special program.** Safety is a priority, and we want to be sure that staff members are present for supervision. **Please make sure children are not on campus prior to 8:35 a.m. and leave promptly by 3:45 p.m.**

ParentVUE – Synergy (PSD Student Information System)

Parents/guardians can access grades, attendance, schedules, and other student information through the Synergy parent portal. Complete secure logon through the ParentVUE/StudentVUE portal or through the apps, which can be downloaded from the iTunes Store and Google Play.

Parents/guardians can only see their student's information. Parents/guardians must have "educational rights" to access ParentVUE. Once educational rights are reflected in Synergy, parents will receive an email with a user activation code.

School Meals
