### Thunderbird Update – September 17, 2021

We want to thank our parents/guardians for continuing to keep children home when they are not feeling well. Please screen your child for symptoms prior to sending him/her to school. <u>Can I go to school</u> <u>symptom check</u>

As always, we ask that you continue monitoring your child and keep them at home if they begin experiencing any symptoms (runny nose, new or worsening cough, fever of 100.4 F or higher and more). PSD strictly adheres to the state's Return to Learn guidelines. If symptoms begin, we encourage you to be tested for COVID-19. Please notify us immediately at (970-488-5000) if any member of your household tests positive.

### New Bell Schedule

Some of you have already noticed the adjustment to our morning bell schedule. Before COVID our standard was to have a bell ring at 8:45 am for students to line up and an 8:50 am bell to signal that all students should be in seats and ready to learn. We are reinstating this practice as our learning time is incredibly important to us and to your children.

- 8:35 a.m. Staff report to duty locations
- 8:45 a.m. First Bell Rings and students line Up at classroom doors
- 8:50 a.m. Second bell rings and class begins students in seats (the 8:50 am bell is considered our tardy bell)

By October 1<sup>st</sup>, we hope all families can adjust back to our pre-COVID standard. Students who arrive in the classroom after 8:50 will be counted as tardy.
