

Thunderbird Update – February 24, 2022



Dear Johnson Families,

Don't forget – tomorrow is the last day that students and staff will have the opportunity to submit mascot ideas. After the submission window closes, a committee will review all entries and select the top two to four. Students and staff will vote for their top choice, and we will announce the winner by April 4, 2022. Design work will then begin for the image of our new mascot.

Submissions that will be considered meet the following criteria:

- The mascot must be inclusive and respectful to all people.
- The mascot must be appropriate for a school with students ranging from 3 to 11 years old.
- The mascot represents the general region/area of the school.
- The mascot is unique and not already taken by another PSD elementary school.
- The mascot should be something staff, students and our community can be proud of.
- If it is an animal, the mascot is common to the area or has relatives here.
- The mascot cannot be copyrighted (i.e. a Disney character, Marvel, professional athletics team mascot, etc.).
- The mascot should reflect our Johnson beliefs and values:
- Submissions should articulate how the suggested mascot reflects our beliefs and values and provide a rationale.
- No artwork should be submitted. The chosen mascot will be submitted to our district Communications Department to create our mascot image.

Positive Behavior Intervention Support (PBIS) is our system for teaching and supporting students to make good choices here at school. Our motto is Thunderbird PRIDE: Participate Positively, Respect Everyone, Insist on Safety, Do your Best, Enjoy Learning. Our students understand what PRIDE means in our school, and we reward students' positive choices. This year we are producing monthly PRIDE videos that are shared with students. The school goal of PBIS is to recognize the positive choices that students make throughout the day and to affirm these choices. We want our students to understand appropriate behaviors and to encourage these behaviors through positive reinforcement.

As a gentle reminder, Colorado brings ever changing weather. Please make sure your child brings the appropriate gear to go out and play. The children love playing in the snow at recess and have such a great time with this. Our temperature cut point for going out is 10°. We do watch for windchill and factor this in. In other words, if the temperature is 20° but windchill says it feels like 7°, we keep the children inside.
