Breakfast at Johnson

Breakfast is available in our cafeteria starting at 8:35 a.m. Students who would like to have breakfast should come to the main front doors, ring the bell, and let the office staff know they are here for breakfast. Breakfast service ends at 8:50 am. If your child arrives to school after this time, make sure they have had breakfast. Breakfast and lunch menus are available on the PSD menu website.

Nutrition Updates

If your student brings a home lunch, but still gets milk from the cafeteria, they will still need to pay for the milk. Milk is 25 cents that could be paid in person by your student, or it can be paid with a credit/debit card through our SchoolPay Website.

We were experiencing an issue with payment files from SchoolPay accounts not being sent to PSD for processing. The issue was identified and fixed the root cause, and we believe the issue is resolved and will not reoccur. Payments made that missed processing should be caught up and available in the student's accounts. Thank you for your patience while system administrators work to complete analysis and fast action to resolve this issue!

Raptor security system

We have a new check in system called Raptor. This is a school wide system, that should be used throughout the district. 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ParentVue - Synergy (PSD Student Information Systems)

Parent/guardians can access grades, attendance, schedules, and other student information through the Synergy parent portal. Complete secure logon through the <u>ParentVUE/StudentVUE Portal</u> or through the apps, which can be downloaded from the iTunes Store and Google Play.

Parent/guardians can only see their student's information. Parents/guardians must have "educational rights" to access ParentVUE. Once educational rights are reflected in Synergy by the school office, parents will receive an email with a user activation code.

Student Code of Conduct

Each year, parents/guardians and secondary students must acknowledge that they have reviewed the Student Rights and Code of Conduct, which is a compilation of rules, policies and regulations regarding student behavior.

Parents/guardians will be asked to acknowledge they have reviewed the Student Rights and Code of Conduct when they log into the <u>ParentVUE parent portal</u>. Parent/guardians will not be given access to ParentVUE until they electronically sign the acknowledgement. This box only needs to be checked once per year (once for elementary students and once for secondary students, if you have students in different grade levels) to gain access to ParentVUE.

Parents of students in secondary schools (6-12): Your student will also be asked to acknowledge having received the Students Rights and Code of Conduct when logging into StudentVUE for the first time this school year.

Families new to PSD or those who have never accessed their ParentVUE account have received a separate email with instructions for how to log into ParentVUE. If you have questions regarding ParentVUE or StudentVUE, see the <u>ParentVUE FAQ</u> or contact your school.

Transportation

PSD's Transportation department is striving to maximize student ridership while following state and county safety guidelines for bus transportation. For the most up to date information on bussing in PSD, visit the <u>Transportation website</u>. The "Here Comes the Bus" app helps parents know where their child's bis is. <u>Here Comes the Bus</u>, which provides the real-time location of each bus, can be accessed through desktop or mobile devices. The information is secure, provided to parents through a private ID that grants access to only their child's bus information. Full-access subscriptions are free to PSD parents. The app is available in the Apple iTunes Store or Google Play. The create an account, use the PSD school

code 75840. The app is designed to increase convenience for parents during hectic mornings and provide another layer of safety for students. Schedule changes and bus delays due to traffic or weather are easy to find, and users can choose to receive push notifications when the bus is within five minutes of their stop.
