- Regular
- Ongoing

- Help in small groups
- Help with field trips
- Help with an activity or club
- Help with a classroom party
- Help in the library/specials

Student Code of Conduct

Each year, parents/guardians and secondary students must acknowledge that they have reviewed the Student Rights and Code of Conduct, which is a compilation of rules, policies and regulations regarding student behavior.

Parents/guardians will be asked to acknowledge they have reviewed the Student Rights and Code of Conduct when they log into the [ParentVUE parent portal](#). Parent/guardians will not be given access to ParentVUE until they electronically sign the acknowledgement. This box only needs to be checked once per year (once for elementary students and once for secondary students if you have students in different grade levels) to gain access to ParentVUE.

Parents of students in secondary schools (6-12): Your student will also be asked to acknowledge having received the Students Rights and Code of Conduct when logging into StudentVUE for the first time this school year.

Transportation

PSD's Transportation department is striving to maximize student ridership while following state and county safety guidelines for bus transportation. For the most up to date information on bussing in PSD, visit the [Transportation website](#). The "Here Comes the Bus" app helps parents know where their child's bus is. [Here Comes the Bus](#), which provides the real-time location of each bus, can be accessed through desktop or mobile devices. The information is secure, provided to parents through a private ID that grants access to only their child's bus information. Full-access subscriptions are free to PSD parents. The app is available in the Apple iTunes Store or Google Play. To create an account, use the PSD school code 75840. The app is designed to increase convenience for parents during hectic mornings and provide another layer of safety for students. Schedule changes and bus delays due to traffic or weather are easy to find, and users can choose to receive push notifications when the bus is within five minutes of their stop.
