#### **Outdoor Recess Guidelines**

As a gentle reminder, Colorado brings ever changing weather. Please make sure your child brings the appropriate gear to go out and play. The children love playing in the snow at recess and have such a great time with this. Our temperature cut point for going out is 10 degrees. We do watch for windchill and factor this in. In other words, if the temperature is 20 degrees but windchill says it feels like 7 degrees, we keep the children inside.

### Student Pick-up During the School Day/Late Arrival

If your child arrives late to school (after 8:50 AM) and teacher has already closed her outside classroom door, please walk your student(s) to the main front door near the office. Office staff will ask you to sign your student in.
