Wow! Spring Break is next week, already! Please look through this update as it has A LOT of information on it.



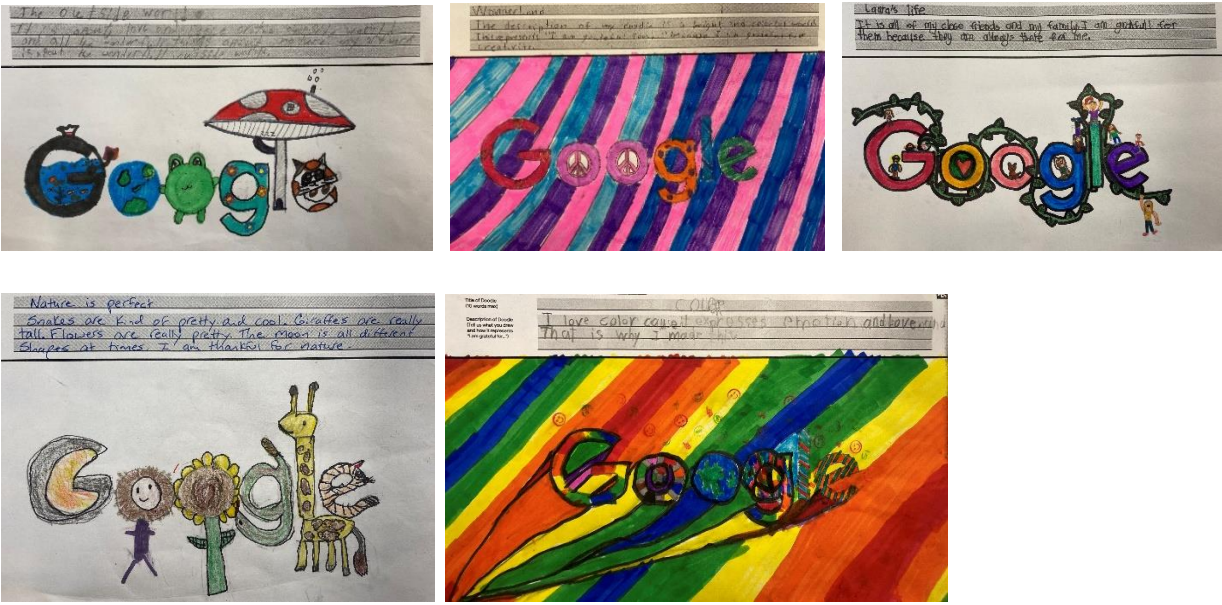
Copy Paper Donations

Thank you to everyone who participated in the Doodle for Google contest! We had many participants and lots of great artwork. Your entries have been mailed off.

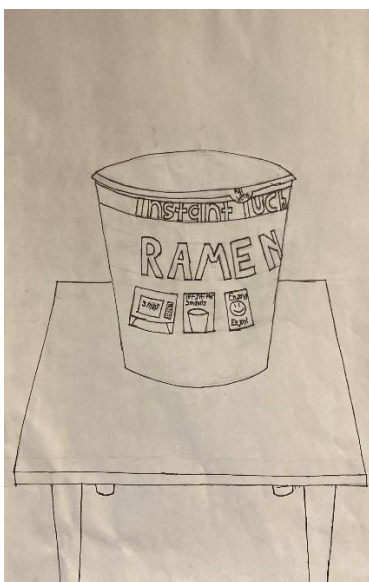


Youth Art Month

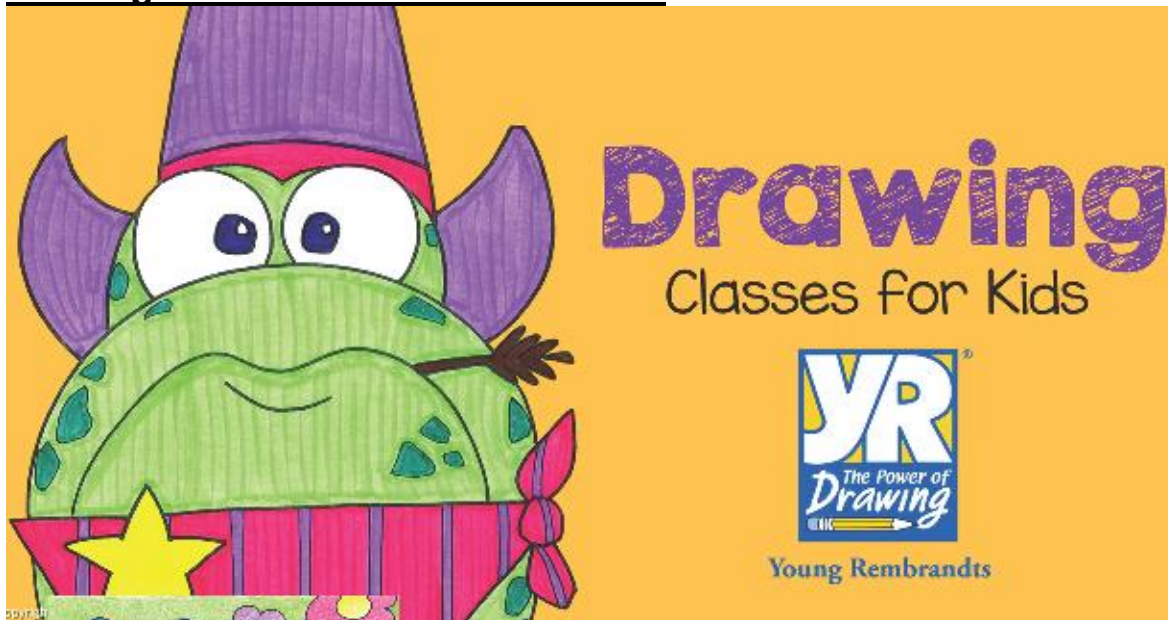
